

Rules for Jim Crow Voting Exercise:

1. You will be dismissed by row to approach the voting tables – one row will vote at a time.
2. You, the voter, will approach 1 of the 2 voting tables.
3. You will be required to pay a **poll tax** of \$2 in order to vote. The election worker will collect the **poll tax**

In 1910 the average monthly wages for Rural:

Whites = \$42 (\$10.50/week)

Blacks = \$28 (\$7.00/week)

4. The election worker will determine if a **literacy test** is required. In our state (the state of Macania) we have **grandfather clauses** on our books so white people need not take a **literacy test**. All black voters will be required to take a test.

5. You will circle one of the two candidates on the ballot and return your ballot to the election workers.

6. The election workers will tabulate the ballots and determine a Presidential winner.
